2. Julie asked her friends which types of books they liked the best. 3 liked fairy tales the best. 5 liked history the best. 9 liked mystery the best. Which type of book was liked the least?

3. Tina asks her friends about their favorite game. 4 children like tag best. 3 children like jump rope best. 5 children like hopscotch best. How many friends does Tina ask?

4. Joe asks his friends what their favorite kind of juice is. 3 like apple juice the best. 7 like orange juice the best. 9 like cranberry juice the best. How many friends does Joe ask?

5. Rachel takes a survey of 16 classmates, 4 children like apples best. 7 children like bananas best. The rest of the children like watermelon best. How many tally marks does Rachel make for watermelon?

6. Daniel surveys 19 of his friends for their favorite school subject. English and history each get a score of 5. 2 students like science best. The rest of his friends like math the best. How many tally marks does Daniel make for math?
