4. Jasmine makes a set of number cards. The cards follow a pattern. The first four cards are numbered 45, 50, 55, 60. What are the next three number cards she will make?

5. Jay writes a different number on a T-shirt for each person on the math team. Jay's number is 9. Each of the other numbers has 9 in the ones place. What number did Jay count by to choose the numbers?

6. Scott has 2 pairs of gloves. Each glove has 5 fingers. How many fingers are there in all?
