Vocabulary

digit Any of the symbols 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9.

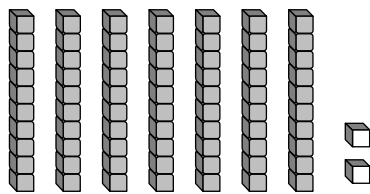
even number A number where you make groups of two and have none left over.

odd number A number where you make groups of two and have one left over.

Find the Value of a Digit

To find the value of a digit, find the value of the place it is in.

Find the value of the digits in 72.



72	
Tens	Ones
7	2

7 tens and 2 ones

The value of
7 tens is 70.

$$\underline{70} + \underline{2}$$

The value of
2 ones is 2.

The number 72 has two digits, 7 and 2.
