# Writing Practice 1-10

Handwriting practice lines for numbers 1 through 10. Each row contains two dashed numbers for tracing on a set of three horizontal lines (top, middle-dashed, bottom). Arrows and dots indicate the starting point and direction of the stroke(s).

- Row 1: Number 1. Stroke starts at a dot on the top line, goes straight down to the bottom line.
- Row 2: Number 2. Stroke starts at a dot on the top line, curves down to the bottom line, then curves back up to the middle dashed line.
- Row 3: Number 3. Stroke starts at a dot on the top line, curves down to the bottom line, then curves back up to the middle dashed line and down again to the bottom line.
- Row 4: Number 4. Stroke starts at a dot on the top line, goes down to the middle dashed line, then right to the bottom line, then up to the top line.
- Row 5: Number 5. Stroke starts at a dot on the top line, goes down to the middle dashed line, then right to the bottom line, then curves down to the bottom line.
- Row 6: Number 6. Stroke starts at a dot on the top line, goes down to the middle dashed line, then curves down to the bottom line.
- Row 7: Number 7. Stroke starts at a dot on the top line, goes right to the middle dashed line, then down to the bottom line.
- Row 8: Number 8. Stroke starts at a dot on the top line, curves down to the bottom line, then curves back up to the top line.
- Row 9: Number 9. Stroke starts at a dot on the top line, curves down to the bottom line, then curves back up to the middle dashed line.
- Row 10: Number 10. Stroke starts at a dot on the top line, goes down to the bottom line, then curves back up to the top line.
