## Vocabulary

**ones** Single objects.



These are 5 **ones**.

**tens** Groups of ten objects.



These are 2 **tens**.



In the number 25, the 2 stands for 2 **tens**, and the 5 stands for 5 **ones**.

**skip count** Start with a number and keep adding on the same number.

2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12...

This shows a way to **skip count** by twos.
