

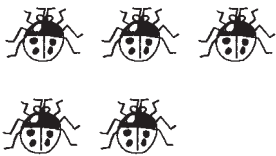
Comparing More and Fewer

1. Al has **3** bugs.
Tom has **2** bugs.
How many more bugs does Al have?



$$3 - 2 = \underline{\quad}$$

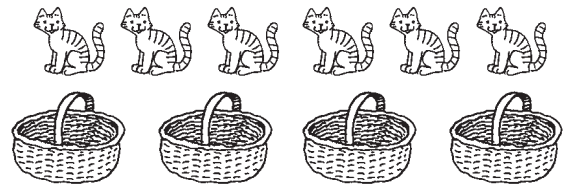
3. There are **7** children.
There are **5** glasses of milk.
How many fewer glasses of milk than children are there?

$$7 - 5 = \underline{\quad}$$

5. Tina has **5** cookies and **4** candies. Rosa has **4** cookies and **3** candies. How many fewer things to eat does Rosa have than Tina?

$$\underline{\quad} - \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$$

2. There are **6** cats.
There are **4** baskets.
How many fewer baskets than cats are there?



$$6 - 4 = \underline{\quad}$$

4. Barb has **8** apples.
Ray has **5** apples.
How many more apples does Barb have than Ray?

$$8 - 5 = \underline{\quad}$$

6. Luke has **3** big rocks and **8** small rocks. Stu has **5** big rocks and **7** small rocks. How many more rocks does Stu have than Luke?
