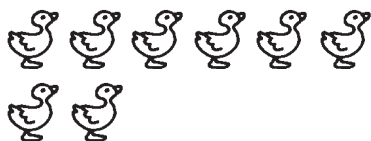
Count on to add.

Use cubes if you wish.

1. There are **6** ducks in the pond.

Two more ducks come.

How many ducks are there in all?



$$6 + 2 = \underline{\quad\quad} \text{ ducks}$$

3. There are **7** children standing.

There are **2** children sitting.

How many children are there in all?

$$7 + 2 = \underline{\quad\quad} \text{ children}$$

5. There are **8** birds sitting on a fence.

**3** more birds fly to the fence.

**2** birds are robins.

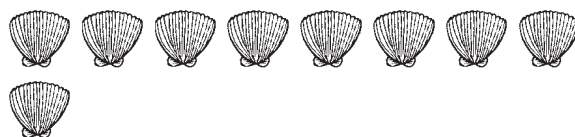
How many birds are on the fence?

$$\underline{\quad\quad} + \underline{\quad\quad} = \underline{\quad\quad} \text{ birds}$$

2. Ian found **8** shells.

Then he found **1** more.

How many shells does he have in all?



$$8 + 1 = \underline{\quad\quad} \text{ shells}$$

4. Mrs. Kim put **9** cookies in a bag.

Then she put in **3** more cookies.

How many cookies are in the bag?

$$9 + 3 = \underline{\quad\quad} \text{ cookies}$$

6. Mark has **7** red crayons and **1** black crayon.

Chris has **3** red crayons.

How many red crayons do they have in all?

$$\underline{\quad\quad} + \underline{\quad\quad} = \underline{\quad\quad} \text{ crayons}$$
