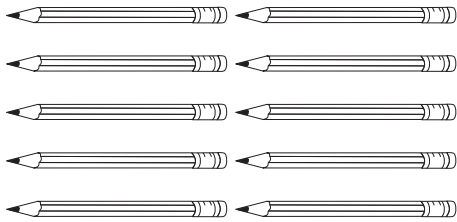

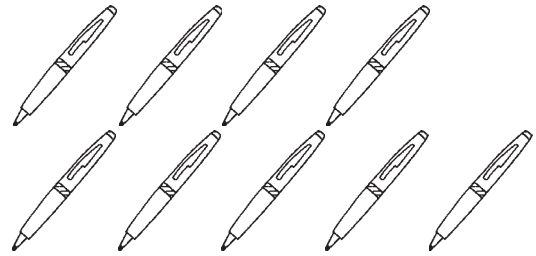
3. Mark has 8 pieces of chalk in a box. He has the same number of pieces in another box. How many pieces of chalk does Mark have in all?
