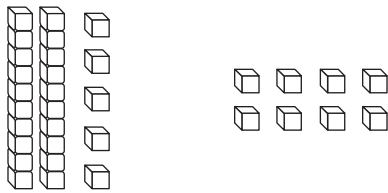

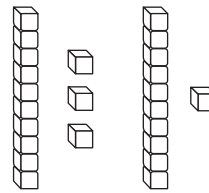
3. Josh and Reggie bring their rock collections to school. Josh has 32 rocks. Reggie has 27 rocks. How many rocks do the boys have in all?
