1. The U.S. National Park System takes care of 58 national parks and 10 national seashores. How many parks and seashores is that in all?

3. Founded in 1872, Yellowstone National Park is our country's oldest national park. Shoshone National Forest is our country's oldest national forest. It was founded 19 years after Yellowstone. In what year was Shoshone National Forest founded?

5. New Mexico, Ohio, and South Carolina each have one national park. New Mexico's Carlsbad Caverns is 73 square miles. Ohio's Cuyahoga Valley is 51 square miles. South Carolina's Congaree National Park is 33 square miles. What is the combined area of all three parks?
