2. In 2003, the Summer Smash Festival had 148,982 attendees. In 2004, the festival had 151,382 attendees. In 2005, the festival had 148,442 attendees. Order the numbers from least to greatest.

4. India has 8,407 universities, Mexico has 1,341, Argentina has 1,705, U.S. has 5,758, and Spain has 1,415. Place the countries in order from greatest to least number of universities.
