1. Celia is 3 inches shorter than Nina. Nina is the same height as Susan. If Nina is 4 feet 10 inches tall, how tall is Celia?

2. A recipe for muffins calls for 4 cups of flour. How many cups of flour would you need to make 24 muffins?

3. Beverly sold tickets to the school play. She sold 30 tickets and collected \$150. Jeff sold twice as many tickets as Beverly. What was the price of each ticket?

4. Julia is reading a book for a report that is due in 4 days. If she can read 20 pages in 30 minutes, how many hours will it take her to read the book?

5. Marcos has 2 pet cats, Jinx and Minx. Both cats are 5 years old. Jinx weighs 12 lb. Minx's weight is 3 times the age of Jinx. How many more pounds does Minx weigh than Jinx?

6. Simon is painting a wall in his bedroom. He has 2 cans of paint. The wall is 100 square feet in size. Does Simon have enough paint for the wall?
