1. Helen had **8** pennies. She found **4** more. How many pennies does she have now?

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1. Helen had 8 pennies. She found 4 more. How many pennies does she have now?

**12** pennies



2. Steve put 9 pennies in a gumball machine. His sister put in 5 pennies. His mother put in 1 more penny. How many pennies were put in the machine?

**15** pennies



3. Eddie had 8 pennies. His father gave him the same number of pennies. His uncle gave him 2 more. How many pennies does he have now?

**18** pennies
