My class is starting Unit 8. I will be learning about adding and subtracting two-digit numbers. These two pages show what I will learn and have activities for us to do together.

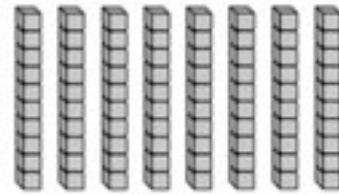

## Vocabulary

These are some words I will use in this unit.

**double** A basic fact that adds the same two numbers, like  $3 + 3 = 6$ ,  $5 + 5 = 10$ , and  $8 + 8 = 16$

**tens** In the number 80, there are 8 tens.



**difference** The answer to a subtraction problem  
In the problem  $60 - 20 = 40$ , 40 is the difference.

The number 20 is called the \_\_\_\_\_ .



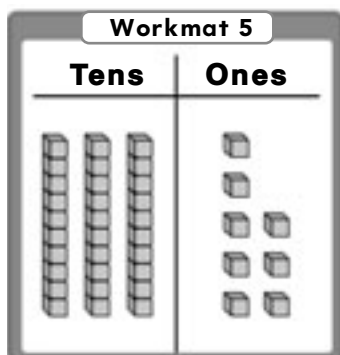
# How To subtract two-digit numbers

## Step 1

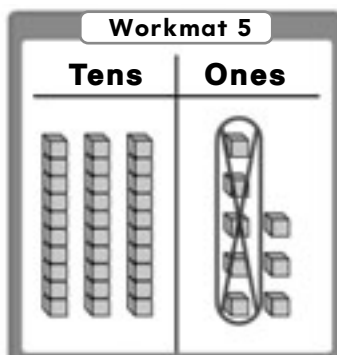
Show 38.

## Step 2

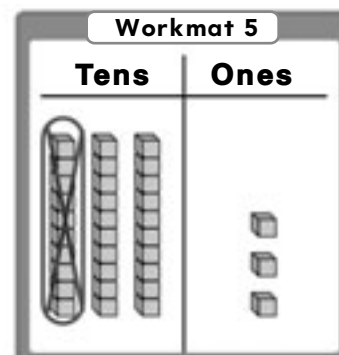
Subtract the ones.
