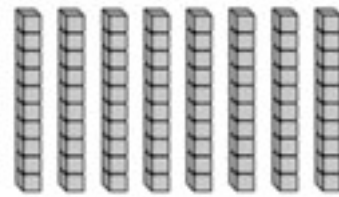
Vocabulary

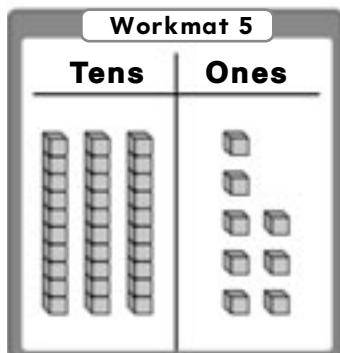
How To subtract two-digit numbers

Step 1

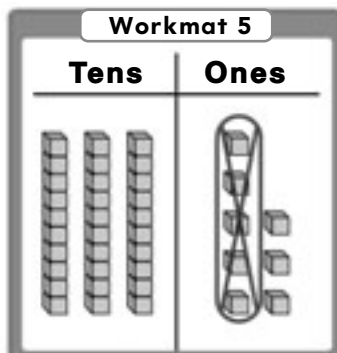
Show 38.

Step 2

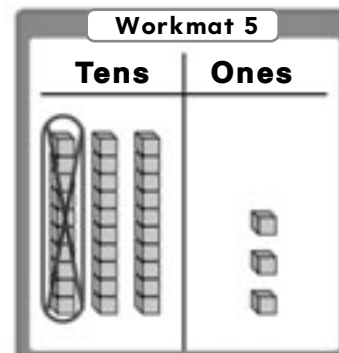
Subtract the ones.
