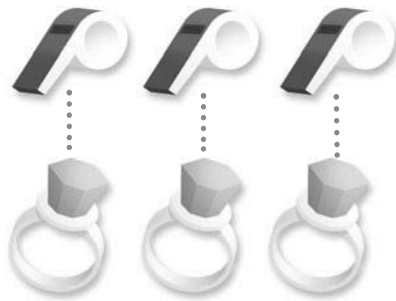

## Vocabulary

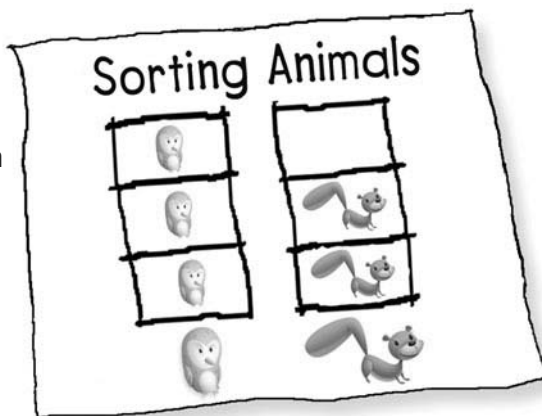
### match one to one

A way to compare the number of objects in two groups.



### graph

Groups of sorted objects arranged in rows or columns to make them easier to compare.



### ordinal numbers

Numbers used to indicate position or order.
