

Compare and Order Numbers

In mathematics, the word **great** means “large”.

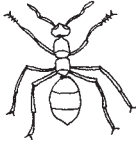
To compare with *great*, we use the words **greater**, and **greatest**.
Greatest means “largest.”

The opposite of **greatest** is **least**. *Least* means “smallest.”

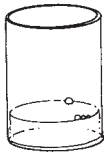
When you order numbers from least to greatest, you go from the smallest number to the largest number.

Circle the picture that answers each question.

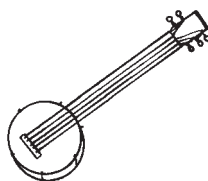
1. Which creature has the greatest number of legs?
