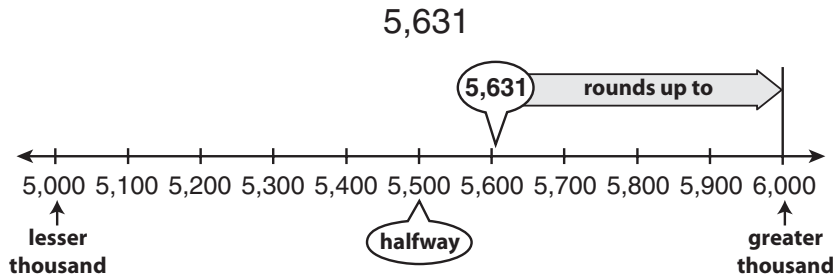

# Round 4-Digit Numbers

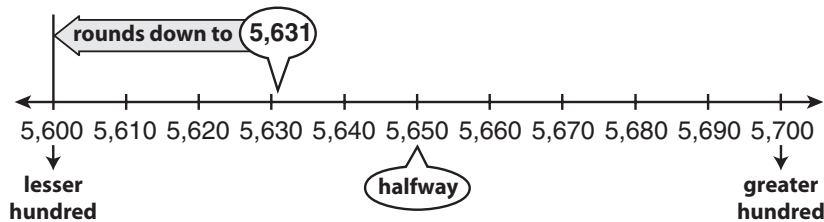

You can round numbers to the nearest thousand. Draw a number line using the lesser thousand and the greater thousand.



The number 5,631 is closer to 6,000 than to 5,000.  
So 5,631 rounded to the nearest thousand is **6,000**.

You can round the same number to the nearest hundred. Draw a number line using the lesser hundred and the greater hundred.



The number 5,631 is closer to 5,600 than to 5,700.  
So 5,631 rounded to the nearest hundred is **5,600**.
