


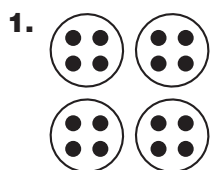

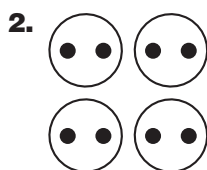

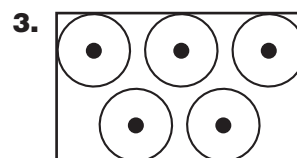


$$4 \times 2 = 8$$
