# Non-Standard and Standard Units of Measure

IN UNIT G, children explore measurement concepts and propose non-standard units for length, mass, capacity, and time. After exploring non-standard units, students move to measuring with customary units. Activities include making and using a yardstick and converting between yards, feet, and inches. In the Measurement Day lesson, children have opportunities to measure length, time, capacity, weight, mass, and temperature in metric and customary units. Activities include finding referents, converting between units, and selecting appropriate tools and units.
