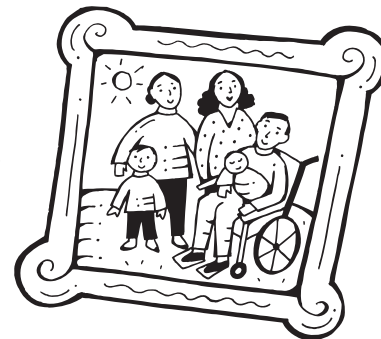

### Home Activities



#### Around the Neighborhood

Children will listen to a story about the places a dog and its owners go to in their neighborhood. Ask your child to tell you about the story. Prompt him/her to use the words *first, next, and last*.

#### Sort Objects

Have your child sort objects in your home by size, shape, or color. Then have her/him count how many objects are in each set.
