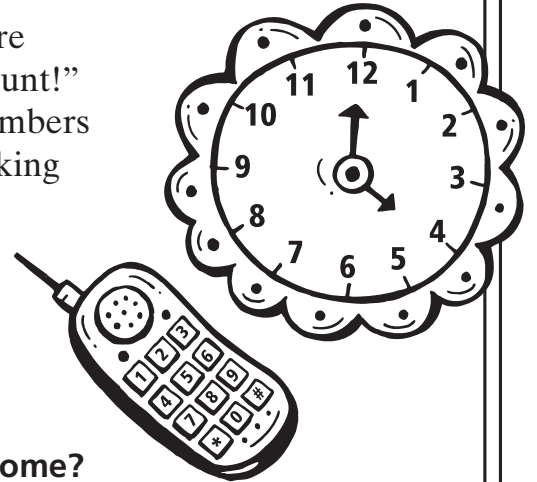


Dear Family,
