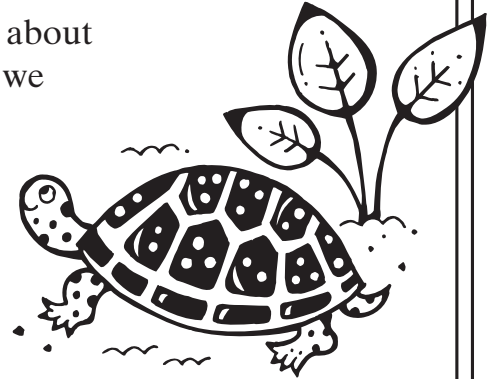


Dear Family,

#### Zz Collage

Write Zz at the top of a large piece of paper. Help your child find Zz and pictures of objects whose names begin with Zz in magazines or catalogs. Glue them onto the paper. You can also draw your own pictures of Zz objects.

#### Animal Homes

Your child will listen to a story titled “Who’s in Rabbit’s House?” Ask her/him to tell you who was in Rabbit’s house. Read other books about animals with your child. Point out and discuss the different places where the animals live.
