



**How to make:** Cover the bulletin board with blue paper to resemble the ocean. Title the board “Gone Fishing.” Draw a long, wavy line under the title to represent waves. Cut three boats out of posterboard, and draw one of the Picture Clues **umbrella**, **eel**, or **ocean** on each. Staple the bottoms and sides of the boats, leaving the top of each boat open and bowed away from the board. Cover a large shoe box with blue paper, label it *Fish*, and attach it to the bottom of the bulletin board. Cut twelve fish from construction paper, and print one Basic Word from Units 7 and 8 on each. Fasten a paper clip or brad to each fish. Make a fishing pole by taping a piece of string to a wooden yardstick. Tie a small magnet to the end of the string.

**How to use:** Have children take turns “fishing” in the shoe box and placing the fish they “catch” in the boat labeled with the correct Picture Clue.
