



How to make: Cover the bulletin board with travel maps. Create an oversized travel journal by stapling five large sheets of paper to the bulletin board in the form of a book. Label each of the five pages of the travel journal with the words *Unit 25*, *Unit 26*, *Unit 27*, *Unit 28*, or *Unit 29*, and divide each page into five sections labeled *Monday*, *Tuesday*, *Wednesday*, *Thursday*, *Friday*. Title the bulletin board “Have Words—Will Travel.”

How to use: Each day one student volunteers to write an entry of three or four sentences into the travel journal. The student uses at least one of the Basic Words from the unit being studied and highlights the word with a highlighter pen. The first volunteer, writing in the first person, begins an adventure tale that will continue for five weeks. Students should understand that the journal will be a continuous story in which each journal entry builds upon the previous entry.
