



**How to make:** Cover a bulletin board with brown paper. Make six buildings of various sizes and shapes, like those shown, and staple them to the board. Label the top of each building with one of the following: *The VCCV Pharmacy*, *VCCCV Pet Supplies*, *Final |ər| Diner*, *Final |n| or |ən| and ||| or |al| Bank*, *The Compound Words Theater*, and *Hotel Homophones*. Students may want to complete the scene by drawing other objects, such as trees, cars, people, and so on to make the bulletin board look like a street. Make an envelope from a manila folder and staple it to the bulletin board. Make 100 cards for the Basic Words from Units 7–11, and have the students write one Basic Word on each card. Put all the cards in the envelope.

**How to use:** Have students identify spelling and syllable patterns, compound words, and homophones by choosing a word from the envelope and tacking the word to the appropriate building.
