



How to make: Title the bulletin board "Bull's Eye." Make a large dart board from construction paper. Use a different color for each circle. If you are working with Unit 31, write a different prefix in each circle. For Units 32 and 33, write a different suffix in each circle. Make a scoring chart, assigning a different number of points to each color. Then make twenty "darts" from cardboard. Write a Basic Word on each dart, but omit the prefix or the suffix that is on the dart board. Draw a line in place of the prefix or suffix. Put all the darts in an envelope. Provide pins as well. Last, tack a blank sheet of paper next to the dart board.

How to use: Students take turns drawing a dart from the envelope and saying the Basic Word suggested by the letters written on the dart. The student then pins the dart to the appropriate prefix or suffix on the dart board and writes the spelling word on the blank sheet of paper. If the student attaches the dart to the wrong circle, he or she must return it to the envelope. Let each student keep his or her own score by referring to the scoring chart. When all the darts have been attached, the student with the most points wins the game.
