



How to make: Title the bulletin board "Word Guess." Write all the Basic Words from Units 31–35 on individual cards. Place the cards in a manila envelope labeled *Basic Words* and staple it to the bulletin board. Have each student cut 20 2"×2" blank cards for his or her own use.

How to use: One student goes to the bulletin board with a pen and the blank cards. He or she then selects a word from the envelope and tacks as many blank cards to the bulletin board as there are letters in the word. If the word he or she has selected is actually two words, the student should provide an obvious gap between the words.

Students call out letters in order to guess the word. If the letters called out are in the word, the student at the board prints them on the blank cards in the appropriate places on the board. If a letter not in the word is guessed, the student at the board prints the letter on a separate card and tacks it to a corner of the board as a reminder. The first student to call out the word correctly will be the next one to go to the board.
