

Spelling Game

Spelling Bingo

Players: entire class, plus a caller

You need: 20 pennies for each player, paper, pencils, list of Unit 12 Spelling Words

How to play: Draw a bingo card with 25 spaces (five rows of five). Choose five Spelling Words from each of Units 7–11. Write one word in each square.

1. The caller reads a word from the list of Spelling Words and checks it off.
2. Players look for the word on their bingo cards. If they have it, they cover the word with a penny.
3. The first player to cover five words in a row (down, across, or diagonally) calls “Bingo!” Then he or she reads each word aloud, and the caller makes sure they are crossed off. To win, the player who called “Bingo!” must correctly spell each word aloud.
4. The winner becomes the new caller for another round of Spelling Bingo.

Other ways to play this game: Play “Cover Up” by continuing to play until every space on one player’s board has been covered with a penny.
