

# Spelling Game

## Ah-choo!

**Players:** 4–6

**You need:** 4–6 lists of Unit 28 Basic Words, pencils

**How to play:** Players sit in a circle on the floor or in chairs. Each player should have a list of Spelling Words.

1. Player 1 chooses a Spelling Word and spells it aloud, substituting “ah-choo” for the letters **o** and **r** in the word. For example, the word **shore** would be spelled “**s-h-ah-choo-e**.”
2. The player seated to the right of Player 1 spells the word correctly, without peeking at the word list. If the word is spelled correctly, this player chooses and spells the next “ah-choo” word.
3. Players should choose words in random order, crossing off each word as it is chosen.

If a player spells a word incorrectly, the player seated to his or her right tries to spell the word. Play continues around the circle until all the Spelling Words have been spelled correctly.

**Other ways to play this game:** Substitute the “shhh” sound for the letter **s**, which is another letter found in many list words. For example, the word *shore* would then be spelled “shhh-**h-ah-choo-e**.”
