

Spelling Game

Spelling Baseball

Players: 8 or more

You need: 4 chairs, list of Unit 6 Spelling Words

How to play: Arrange the chairs in the shape of a baseball diamond. Form two teams. Teams take turns being “at bat” and “in the field.” When in the field, players sit in the middle of the diamond and “pitch” words from the list of Unit 6 Spelling Words to batters. When at bat, players come to the plate one at a time and try to spell these words. Players move ahead one base for each correct spelling. Players earn one out for each incorrect spelling. The inning continues until there are three outs. The team with the most “runs” at the end of two (or more) innings wins.
