

Spelling Game

Spelling Hopscotch

Players: 3–4

You need: chalk or marker, a list of Unit 3 Basic Words, pencil and paper for keeping score, large paper bag, 20 index cards

How to play: While playing hopscotch, players practice spelling Basic Words orally.

- Players draw the hopscotch pattern on the sidewalk or on large paper on the floor, numbering the squares from 1 to 8. A player writes each Basic Word on a separate index card and places the cards in the bag.
- The first player draws a card from the bag. The others look at the word and say it aloud. Then the first player hops on the pattern, landing on one foot in single squares and two feet in double squares. Upon reaching the end of the pattern, the player turns around, spells the word, and hops back to square 1. It is now the next player's turn.
- Each player gets 1 point for spelling the word correctly and 1 point for completing the hopscotch pattern correctly. Play continues until each word has been drawn. The player with the most points wins.
