

# Spelling Game

## Penny Slide and Spell

**Players:** 3–5, plus a caller

**You need:** paper, markers, penny, list of Unit 7 Basic Words numbered from 1 to 20

**How to play:** Players take turns at the shuffleboard and spell words.

- Students use markers to draw a shuffleboard court on paper, numbering the squares as shown. The caller uses pencil and paper to keep score.
- To begin, Player 1 slides the penny from the start line to a numbered square. The caller reads the word that corresponds to the number. If Player 1 spells the word correctly, he or she crosses off the number and receives one point. Then Player 2 takes a turn.
- If a player lands on a crossed-off square, he or she loses a turn. If the penny slides off the court, the player loses a turn. If a penny lands on two squares, the caller decides which square to use. Play continues until all the numbers have been crossed off. The player with the most points wins.
