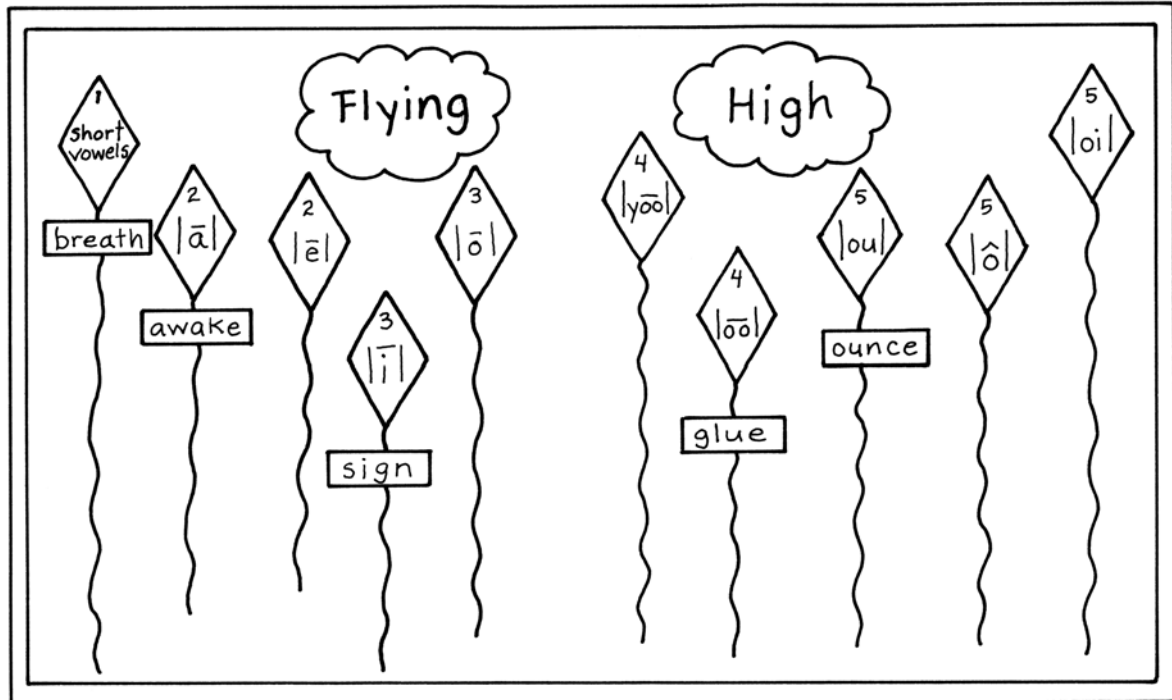


BULLETIN BOARD



How to make: Cut ten kites from different colored construction paper. Label each kite with a unit number and one of the vowel sounds taught in that unit. (For example, for Unit 1, write 1 and *short vowels* on one kite.) Attach the kites to the bulletin board in a row, staggered as shown. Give each kite a tail by tacking one end of a long piece of yarn to the bottom point of the kite and letting the yarn dangle down the board.

For the title of the bulletin board, cut two cloud shapes from white paper, write *Flying High* on them (one word on each cloud), and attach them at the top of the bulletin board.

How to use: Have students write Basic Words from Units 1–5 on strips of different colored construction paper. Mix the strips. Then have students sort the words by vowel sounds. Let them tape each strip on the tail of the correct kite.
