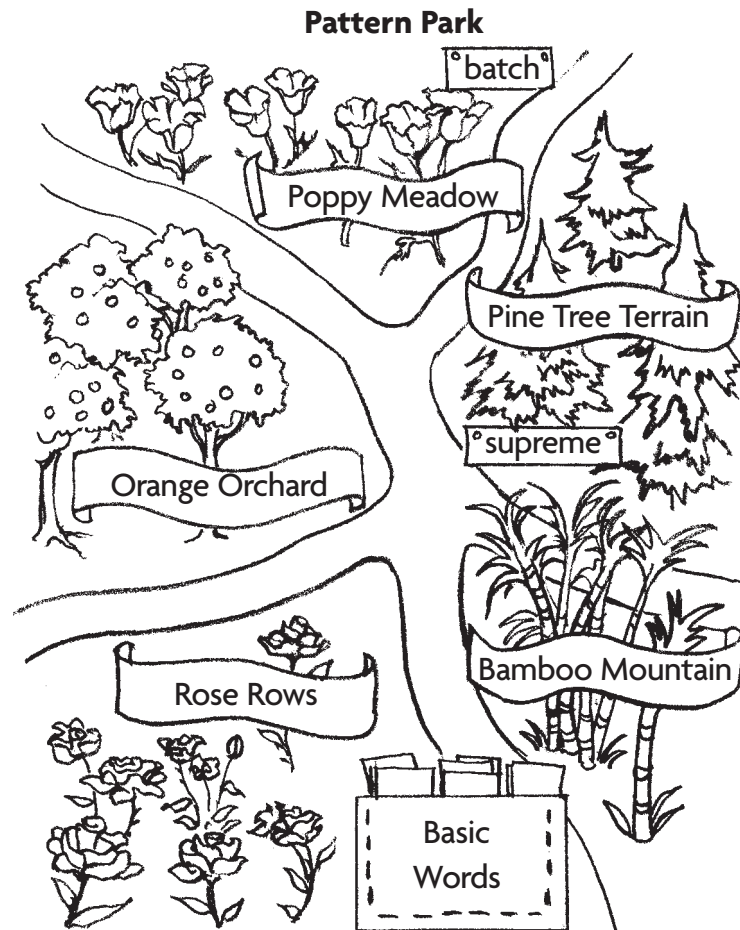


BULLETIN BOARD



How to make: Cover the bulletin board with green paper. Divide the board into five sections, using white walkways as shown. Label the sections *Pine Tree Terrain*, *Bamboo Mountain*, *Poppy Meadow*, *Orange Orchard*, and *Rose Rows*. Title the board *Pattern Park*. Have students draw or cut out trees or other plants that match the name of each section. Make an envelope from a manila folder and staple it to the bulletin board. Make 100 cards for the Basic Words from Units 1–5, and have students write one Basic Word on each card. Put all the cards in the envelope.

How to use: Ask students to identify the spelling pattern or principle that appears in each section heading (*Pine Tree Terrain*—Long Vowels, *Bamboo Mountain*—Vowel Sounds /ou/, /ō/, /ô/, /oi/, *Poppy Meadow*—Short Vowels, *Orange Orchard*—Vowel + /r/ Sounds, *Rose Rows*—Homophones). Have students choose a word card from the envelope and attach the word in the section with the appropriate heading.
