Spelling Go Fish

Players: 2

You need: 20 index cards, a list of words in Unit 35

How to play: Players try to collect as many pairs of cards with easily confused Basic Words on them as possible.

- Players write a Basic Word on each index card. Players then mix the cards, give four cards to each player, and put the remaining cards face down in a pile between them.
- Players try to form pairs of easily confused Basic Words, such as *personal* and *personnel*.
- The first player asks the other player for a card to match one in his or her own hand. For example, “May I have *personnel*?”
- If the opponent has the card with *personnel* on it, he or she must hand it over. If not, the opponent replies, “Go fish.” The player then draws the top card from the deck. If a player forms a match by drawing or by asking the opponent for a card, the player lays the matching cards on the table. He or she reads, spells, and defines each word.
- The first player to form pairs with all of his or her cards wins the game.
