3. **Record Data** Mark each location on the blank world map. Draw a red triangle for a volcano. Draw a green circle for an earthquake. Check your work.

2. Predict Using what you know about Earth's structure, predict the relationship between the planet's plates and the places where most volcanoes and earthquakes occur.
