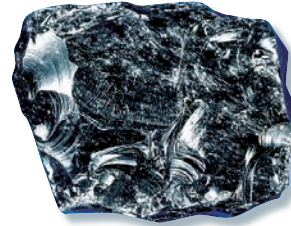


Molten rock hardens to form igneous rock.

Igneous Rock



Obsidian (ahb SIHD ee uhn) is formed when molten rock cools quickly.



Basalt (buh SAWLT) makes up much of Earth's crust beneath the oceans.



Granite (GRAN iht) is molten rock that hardens in the crust.
