TEACHER OR STUDENT PROVIDED ITEMS

3 2-liter plastic bottles, 1 small electric fan, magazines (to be cut up for weather pictures), 2 large metal pot lids for cymbals (or real cymbals), safety matches, 2 tbsp. soil, weather maps and daily weather reports from Internet or newspaper, 5-lb weight (bag of sugar or flour).
