<p>Cold-blooded</p> <p>Breathe with gills</p> <p>Scales cover body</p> <p>Move with tail and fins</p> <p>Live in water</p>	<p>Cold-blooded</p> <p>Young breathe with gills; adults breathe with lungs</p> <p>Thin, moist skin</p> <p>Young have a tail; adults move with legs</p> <p>Live in or near water</p>	<p>Cold-blooded</p> <p>Breathe with lungs</p> <p>Scales cover body</p> <p>Move with legs or by wiggling</p> <p>Live on land</p> <p>Lay eggs with leathery shells or give birth to live young</p>	<p>Warm-blooded</p> <p>Breathe with lungs</p> <p>Have feathers</p> <p>Move with two wings and two legs</p> <p>Live on land; some swim in water</p> <p>Lay eggs with hard shells</p> <p>Bones are hollow and lightweight</p>	<p>Warm-blooded</p> <p>Breathe with lungs</p> <p>Have fur or hair</p> <p>Move with legs or with tail and flippers</p> <p>Live on land or in water</p> <p>Give birth to live young</p> <p>Feed milk to their young</p>
